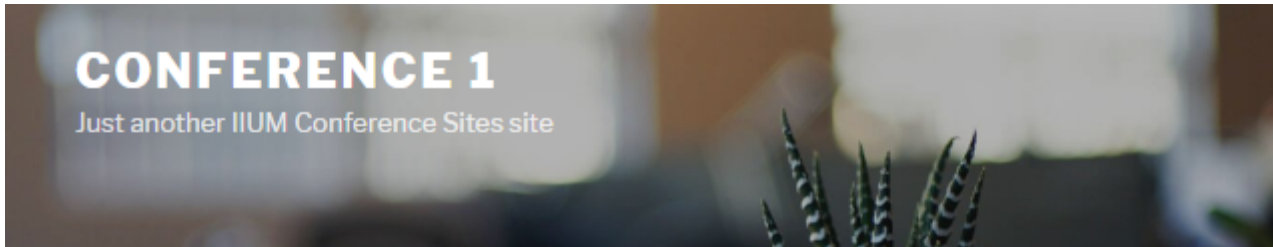


How To Customize

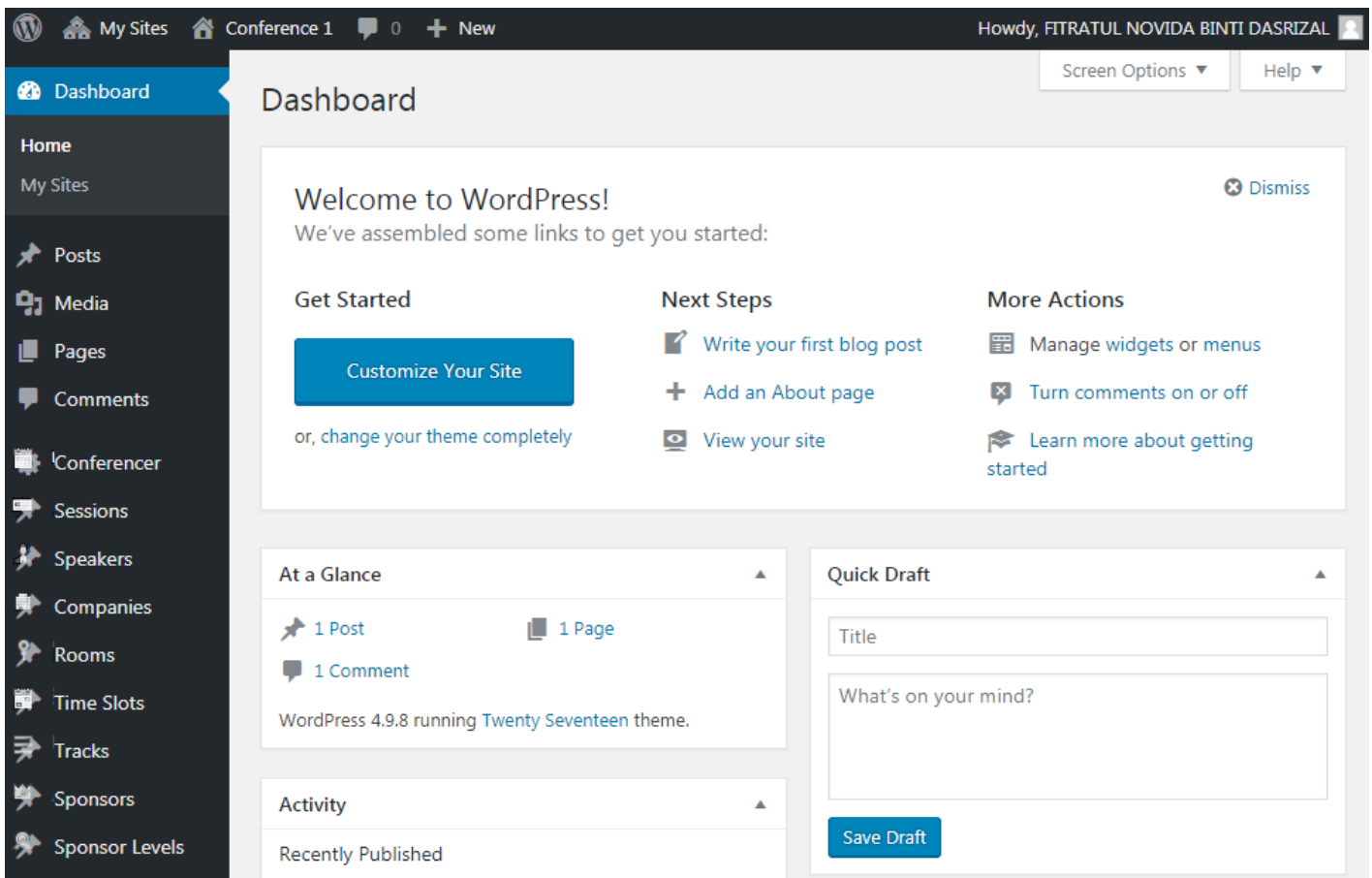

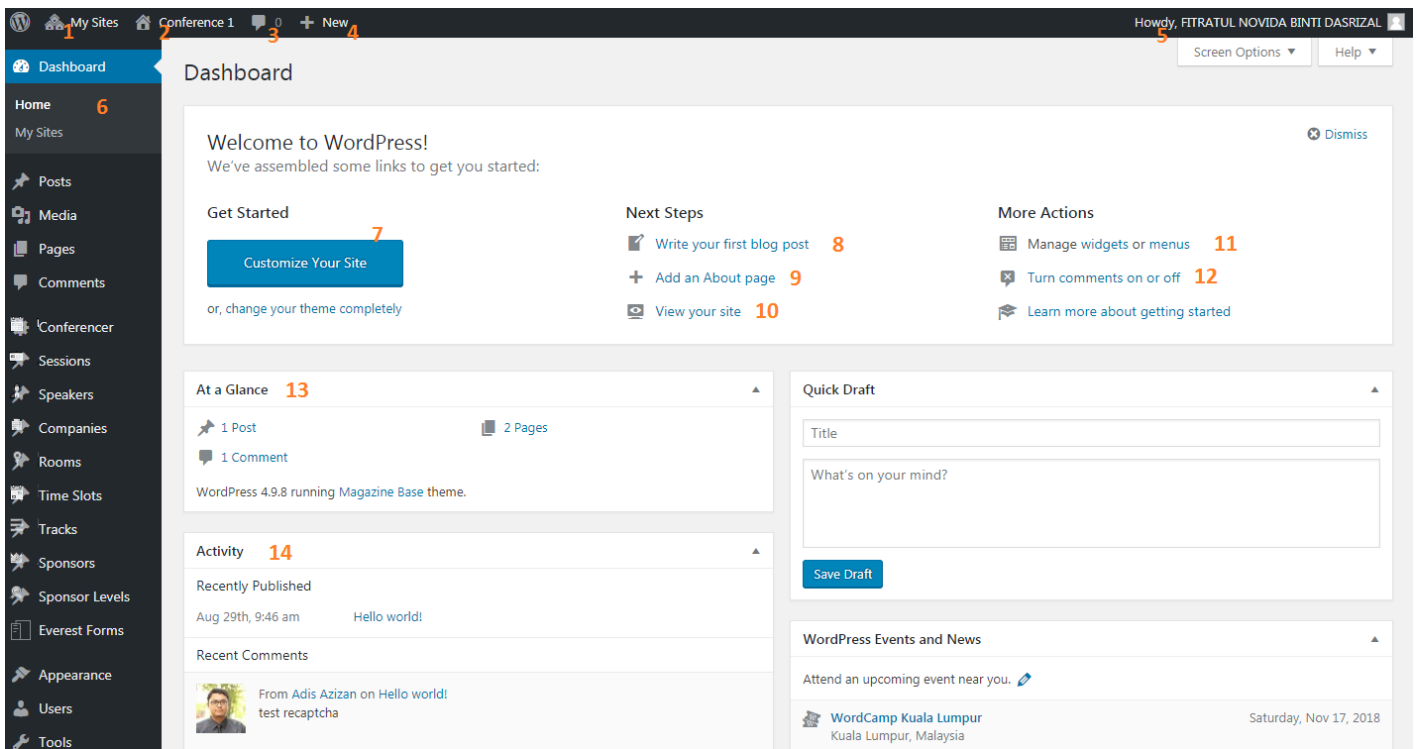

14. View the site activity

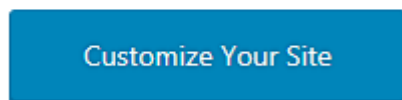

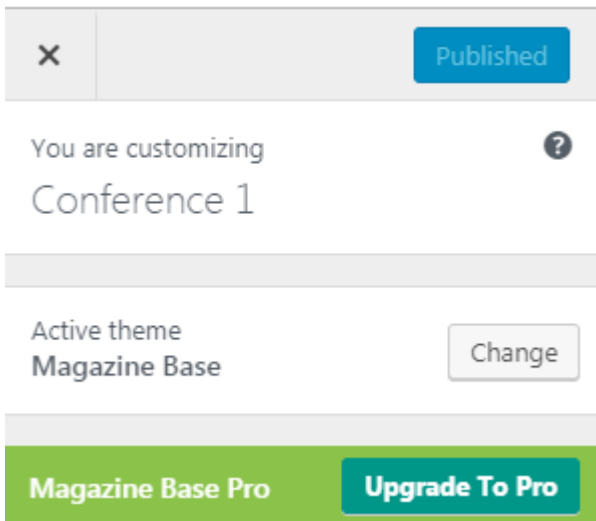

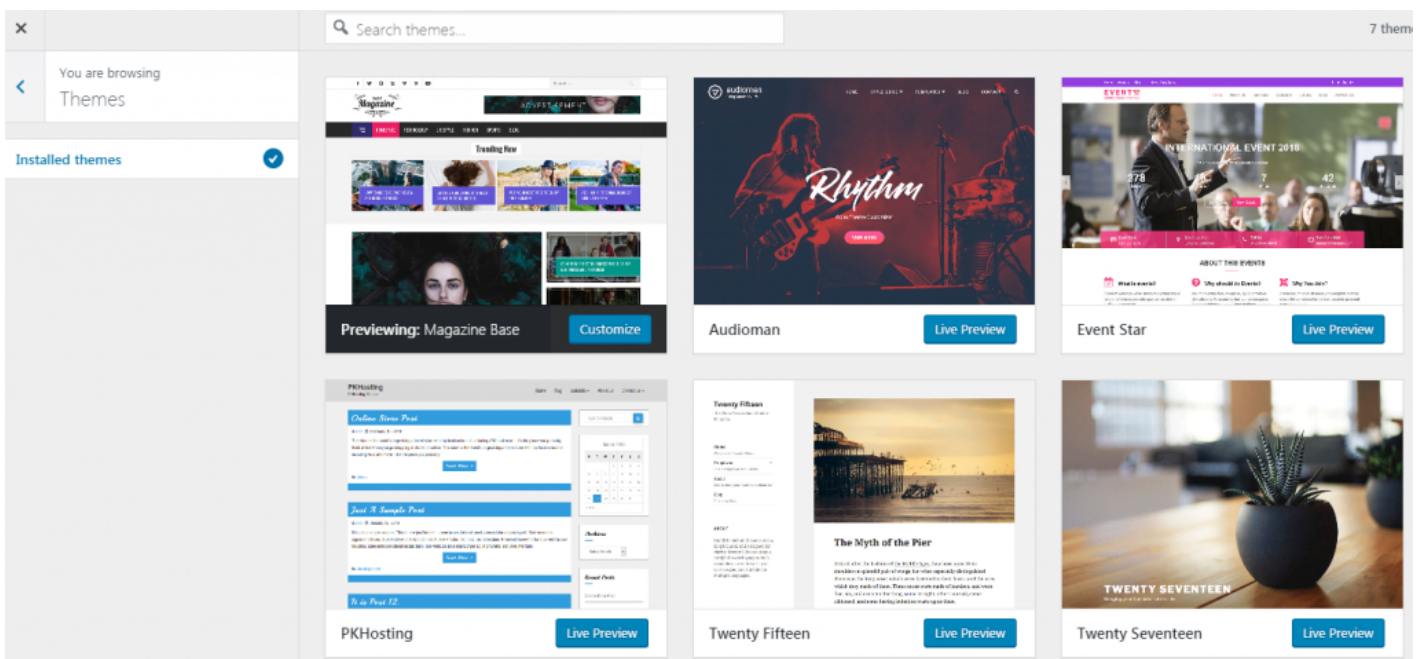
