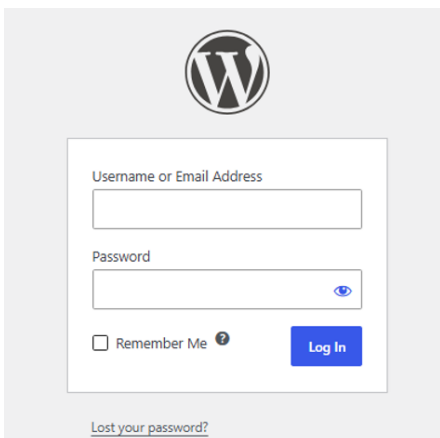


Login with Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)

After **Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)** has been activated, future logins to the WordPress Dashboard will require an additional verification step.

Step 1: Open the WordPress Login Page

Open the WordPress login page.



Step 2: Enter Username and Password

Enter your **username and password** as usual.



Step 3: Click Log In

Click **Log In**.

Step 4: Enter the 2FA Verification Code

After your username and password have been successfully submitted, Wordfence will prompt you to enter your **Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)** verification code.

Open the authenticator application that you used to set up 2FA.

Locate the verification code associated with your **WordPress account**.

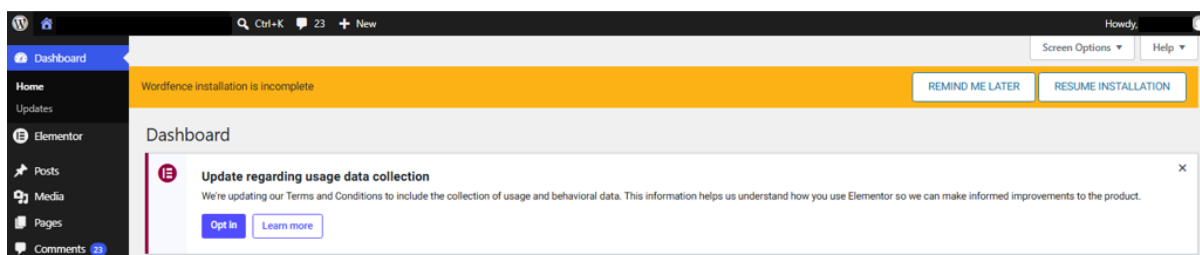
Enter the current verification code into the **2FA Code** field.
